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
Instructions for use¹ of Trivacin transdermal patch (Rivastigmine transdermal patch)

- If you are not sure about anything, please ask your doctor or pharmacist.


Important to follow	<u>How</u> to apply the Trivacin patch	<u>Where</u> to apply the Trivacin patch
Take off the previous patch before putting one new patch on!	 <p>1. Carefully remove the existing patch before putting on one new patch.</p>	Remove the previous day's patch before you apply the new one. Apply one new patch in one of the following zones every day. You can use the same zone (A or B or C or D or E or F or G or H), but do not use the same exact spot within the same zone.
Only one patch per day! Do not cut the patch into pieces!	 <p>2. Cut the sachet at both scissors marks, but not further than the indicated line. Tear the sachet to open. Take out the patch from the sachet and remove the cover sheet from the skin colored side.</p>	 <p>The diagrams show a person's front and back with eight application zones labeled A through H. Zones A, B, and C are on the front (left side, right side, and center chest). Zones D, E, F, G, and H are on the back (left side, right side, and center back). Each zone is a rectangular area. Press the patch firmly in place for at least 30 seconds using the palm of the hand!	 <p>3. Peel off one side of the protective liner and do not touch the sticky part of the patch with the fingers.</p>	
	 <p>4. Put the sticky side of the patch on the selected area and then peel off the second side of the protective liner.</p>	 <p>The diagrams show a person's back with eight application zones labeled E through H. Zones E, F, G, and H are on the back (left side, right side, and center back). Each zone is a rectangular area. Between the four back diagrams, there are labels '- OR -' indicating that any one of these zones can be used.</p>
	 <p>5. Then press the patch firmly in place for at least 30 seconds using the palm of the hand to make sure that the edges stick well.</p>
